TRAINING POLICIES

REGISTRATION

- All participants must pre-register and pay any applicable fees in order to attend the conference. .
- Enrollment is on a first-come, first-served basis.
- A registration form must be completed for each person planning to attend the conference
- **Your registration is not complete until payment has been received.**

- There is a \$30.00 service charge for returned checks or money orders.

CANCELLATIONS

- Conferences may be canceled for several reasons. These reasons include, but are not limited to:
Insufficient registrations Inclement weather Natural disasters
- If a conference is canceled due to circumstances beyond our control, participants will be notified when a new training date has been chosen. Registrations will be transferred to the new training date.
- Participants who cancel at least 24 hours prior to the day of the conference, may receive a letter of credit.
- “No Shows” will not be issued a letter of credit and will forfeit their registration fees.
- Participants may have someone substitute for them if they cannot attend.

REFUNDS

- **We do not issue refunds, EXCEPT when a training date has been cancelled by Early Start Child Care Resource and Referral.** Participants who cancel, may receive a letter of credit to attend another training event hosted by Early Start Child Care Resource & Referral or the Chatham Childcare Collaborative, provided a notice of cancellation is received **AT LEAST 24 hours PRIOR to the date of the conference.**

CLASS ETIQUETTE

- All participants are required to participate in each workshop for the full training time allowed.
- Participants will not be permitted to attend class if they arrive ten minutes or more after the scheduled start of the workshop.
- Participants will not receive credit for the class if they leave ten minutes or more before the scheduled end of the workshop.
- All workshops are hands-on, interactive classes. Participants are expected to actively participate. Failure to participate in the workshop may result in no training credit being received. The following is a list of unacceptable behavior. This list is not all-inclusive: Sleeping, phone calls, leaving class, texting, or disruptive talking/behavior.
- ***To maximize the learning opportunity for each person, please make child care arrangements for your children. Children will not be permitted to attend training workshops.***
